We are a non-profit organization made up of individuals, families, students, businesses and civic organizations who believe libraries are vital for a prosperous community. We meet every third Tuesday in January, April, July, and October at 6pm in the library.

Thanks to all of our patrons and the support of the local communities, we will be moving into a bigger building in 2018. This won't happen overnight with grant writing, remodel, etc, but we are super excited that we will be able to offer more services, more books, and more parking. The mayor and city council also should be recognized, since they see the value of a thriving library in the community.

In the 2017 year we had 12,329 visitors and 1,266 computer uses. We checked out 13,458 books, 1,730 ebooks through Overdrive, 1,267 DVD's, and 74 Hotspots. We added 1,541 books to our collection and withdrew 1,304 for a variety of reasons.

Our Hotspot program is still a huge success with a waiting list of about 10 patrons at any given time. The pilot program ends in May and we hope to be able to continue with the program and possibly add a couple more devices to be checked out.

Our story times continue to be popular, along with the summer reading program.

We are always open to programming suggestions or book recommendations. Just let us know your ideas. I will keep you posted as we move forward with the new library project, and be sure to follow us on facebook for the latest news.


