Isaac Asimov is considered to be one of the fathers of modernday science fiction. A prolific writer, he is thought to have edited and written about 500 books and hundreds of short stories. Considered to be one of the most influential sci-fi writers of all times, Asimov is credited with coining the word robotics and for introducing the Three Laws of Robotics. While he grew up in the US, Asimov was born in Russia sometime between October and January 1920. He officially celebrated his birthday on January 2. Did You Know... that Asimov had a fear of flying? According to some sources, he flew on an airplane only twice in his life. In addition to being aviophobic, he

A year in review...as you all know 2018 was a very busy and rewarding year. It started with a signature on the dotted line in early January to purchase our new space. It progressed with an untold number of volunteer hours in labor plus donations to change a previous daycare into a usable library that our communities could be proud of. We still need to build an addition to the back of the building to make it even more functional and to be able to host all our programs on site instead of going elsewhere to borrow adequate space.

Just a few of our statistics include having 2,175 people attend our various programs. We still have four more programs for the 2018 year so that number will be added to.

We have added 846 new books to our collection and taken out 100 books. These books were taken out of the system due to damage or they were never returned to the library. Currently we have 11,679 books, 950 DVDs and 181 audiobooks. I have 1000 or so new items to add into the collection as time permits.

We have added STEM, a 3D printer, a mini laser engraver and Launchpads to our services. We still offer disc cleaning, hotspots, print, copy, scan, fax, and six public use computers.

If you haven't had a chance to see the new library try to take a few minutes to stop in and check it out...along with a great selection of books, movies, etc.

We will continue to add new books and services as we can. If you

have suggestions or recommendations, please let us know. We are continually trying to make this the best library around. Thanks to all our supporters and hope you have a great new year!




