When: Sat. April 10


Where: library parking lot

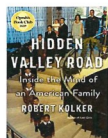
